NOTICE OF RACE

1. **RULES:** The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS); the prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, the participating classes and the Sailing Instructions will govern all races. Rules of all classes are altered so that class membership is not required. Rule 30.1 Round-an-End Rule is in effect at all times (the "T" flag will not be displayed).
2. **CLASSES:** Optimist Green, White, Blue & Red Fleets, Sunfish Green, Red & Blue Fleets, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial and Club 420.
3. **AWARDS:** Optimist & Sunfish Green Fleets participation awards. Optimist Red, White & Blue Fleets, Sunfish Red & Blue Fleets, Laser Radial and 420 Fleets all 1st to 5th. Laser 4.7 Fleet 1st to 3rd. Awards to follow racing. The Junior State Championship Sunfish Trophy is awarded to the top-finishing Sunfish competitor age 8 to 13. The Junior State Championship Sunfish Trophy is awarded to the top-finishing Sunfish competitor age 14 to 17.

5. **FEE:** Entry Fee: - \$35 each skipper if registered by June 15, 2010. \$40 each skipper if registered after June 15, 2009. \$30 each crew in addition to the skipper's fee. Late entries will be accepted on the race day up to the close of registration. The fee includes lunch and a commemorative tee-shirt. Additional lunches are \$5.00 each.
6. **SCHEDULE:** Thursday, July 1, 2010
 - 6.1. 0800-0900 Check In and Late Registration
 - 6.2. 0900-0930 Skippers' Meeting
 - 6.3. 0945 Harbor Start
 - 6.4. 1015 First Warning Signal all Classes. Races to follow
 - 6.5. Lunch break will be on land. Five (5) Races are scheduled. One race constitutes a Regatta.
7. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Will be available at check-in.
8. **VENUE:** The racing will be on the Toms River and Barnegat Bay.
9. **COURSES** -Port triangle courses. Both Opti and Sunfish Green Fleets will sail on one separate course.
10. **SCORING** -The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A2 of the RRS. If more than three races are completed, each boat's worst finish will be excluded from its series score. This changes Rule A2.
11. **OTHER HIGHLIGHTS:**

Lunch will be an old-fashioned July 4th BBQ including hamburgers, hotdogs, chips, watermelon and lemonade. Lunch is included for all registered sailors and one coach per yacht club. Others can purchase a lunch for \$5.00.

We will also be having a greased watermelon challenge and a DJ on the deck after racing has finished.
